

CREDIT INFORMATION

To receive a high school diploma in Alberta, students must earn 100 credits

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To participate in the graduation ceremony, students need to complete 100 credits, including the Religious Studies courses requirement

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TIMETABLING

- Two semester system
 - Semester 1: September to January
 - Semester 2: February to June
- 4 blocks of classes/day on a 2-day schedule
- 5 credit courses students take every day
- 3 credit courses students take every other day
- 1 credit modules




TRANSPORTATION

- All Students requiring transportation (city/county) need to register on the school website
- County Transit
 - County students ride a YELLOW charter bus. Your driver will call you before the school year starts notifying you of location and times.
- City Transit
 - City students will ride City of Red Deer Transit on school days. If you live greater than 2.4 kms from SJHS your city bus pass will be free. If you live closer than 2.4 kms there is a fee for the city bus pass.
 - City Transit passes are available at the office in September
 - There is an option to purchase a non restricted bus pass for weekends.
 - Please see the City of Red Deer Website for city transit bus routes and times



- Both high schools are attendance-based schools.
- If your child does miss school please ensure you call the attendance line and excuse the absence
- Celebrations are instructional minutes and are mandatory
- If absences get too high, students may not be permitted to participate in extracurricular activities.



If a student misses 25% of a class, or more, he or she can be withdrawn from classes and required to take courses through alternative programs (online, outreach, etc.).
